(Amendment) Regulations*

## **SAINT LUCIA**

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT, 2010, No. 64

[ 5th July, 2010 ]

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 53(1) of the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority Act, Cap. 8.13, the Minister responsible for Finance makes these Regulations:

### **Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority (Seaport Tariff) (Amendment) Regulations 2010.

### **Interpretation**

2. In these Regulations “principal Regulations” means the Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority (Seaport Tariff) Regulations, Cap. 8.01.

### **Amendment of Schedule 2**

3. Schedule 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting item 9 and replacing the following:

#### **“9 NAVIGATIONAL AIDS**

The charge per call for navigational aids is as follows:

Two cents per GRT of any ship subject to a minimum charge of \$15.00 and a maximum charge of \$100.00.”

### **Amendment of Schedule 3**

4. Schedule 3 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting after item 7 a new item 8 as follows:

#### **“8 PORT SECURITY FEE**

A Port Security fee shall be charged as follows:

- (a) on break bulk cargo - \$3.00 per ton or part of a ton landed or loaded;
- (b) on containerized cargo - \$3.00 per ton or part of a ton landed or loaded;

- (c) on empty containers - \$3.00 per container;
- (d) on passengers embarking a vessel at the Castries Ferry Terminal - \$3.00 per passenger."

**Amendment to Schedule 5**

5. Schedule 5 of the principal Regulations is amended by:

- (a) deleting paragraph (d) of item 2 and replacing the following:

"(d) Storage charges on empty containers shall be:-

- (i) from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> October - \$7.00 per day per T.E.U.
- (ii) from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 31<sup>st</sup> March - \$9.00 per day per T.E.U.";

- (b) inserting a new paragraph (e) in item 2 as follows:

"(e) Crane charges for the loading and unloading of containers shall be \$217.92 per T.E.U."; and

- (c) deleting item 3 and replacing the following:

**"3. STUFFING AND UNSTUFFING**

A charge shall be made when containers are stuffed or unstuffed by the Authority.

The charge for stuffing containers shall be \$15 per ton or part thereof subject to a minimum charge of \$150 per work day plus the cost of renting equipment from the Authority to undertake the shifting operations and the charge for unstuffing containers shall be \$1315.42 per T.E.U. or part of the T.E.U."

**Amendment to Schedule 7**

6. Schedule 7 of the principal Regulations is amended by:

- (a) deleting item 4 and replacing the following item 4:

**"4. STORAGE CHARGES**

The charges for all cargo remaining in Port Castries and Port Vieux Fort after the free storage period

has elapsed is \$3.50 per day or a fraction of the day per ton or part of a ton.”

(b) deleting paragraph (c) of item 2 and replacing the following:

“(c) for empty containers the following will apply:

- (i) from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> October – 21 days including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays;
- (ii) from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 31<sup>st</sup> March – 21 days excluding Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays.”
