The Government of Saint Lucia (hereinafter called "Borrower") has received financing from the International Development Association (IDA) (the "Bank") in the form of a credit (hereinafter called "credit" toward the cost of the Caribbean Regional Air Transportation Project (CATCOP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Upgrading of Firefighters' Control Room. Payments by the Bank will be made only at the request of the SLASPA and upon approval by the Bank, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the financing agreement. The financing agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the credit account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of the Bank, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than the Borrower shall derive any rights from the financing agreement or have any claims to the proceeds of the credit.
- 2. The Saint Lucia Air and Sea Ports Authority (SLASPA), the implementing agency of the Borrower now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Upgrading of Firefighters' Control Room at the Hewanorra International Airport, located in Vieux Fort, Saint Lucia. The Works consist of Upgrading of the firefighters control room. Key issues include (i) providing a control room with an unobstructed view of the entire runway and ensuring that it is preserved as the airport develops further in the coming years and (ii) ensuring that the room is in close proximity to the CFR station to facilitate rapid communications in the event of an incident. The expected duration of these works is six (6) months. More details on the Works are provided in the Works' Requirements section of the RFB document (Section VII Works' Requirements).
