JOB SUMMARY:

Performs maintenance work on timber and masonry structures, roofs, doors and hardware, plumbing lines and fixtures; assist in the upkeep of berths and hardware; assists in the maintenance of pavements; undertakes construction of minor structures/units; performs painting and tiling at the Authority's facilities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Install timber fixtures with all necessary ironmongery;
- Maintenance works at roofs of the Authority's buildings;
- Perform drywall construction and finish.
- Conduct daily maintenance inspections of building, berthing structures, pavements and report faults or deficiencies to Supervisor for further action;
- Perform moderate joinery/carpentry, plumbing, tiling, roofing, painting, and masonry works as per maintenance schedule or as necessary in keeping with minimum work standards established by the Civil Section;
- Assists in executing repairs to asphalt and concrete pavements;
- Assist in the quantifying and advising on materials for procurement in order to undertake maintenance work;
- Provide maintenance support and monitor contracted civil works on behalf of the Authority to ensure highest product quality and workmanship and report any questionable observations to Supervisor.
- To carry out preventive maintenance as scheduled.
- Provide Technical advice and assistance to speedily resolve maintenance issues;
- Assist in keeping inventory of tools, materials and equipment;
- Completion of work orders generated from Facilities Management Systems (FMS) as per work schedule and as required by Supervisor.

QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS & EXPERIENCE

- Secondary school certificate (at least four CXC passes including English and Mathematics)
- Certificate in Building trades or equivalent 10 years' experience in the field.
- At least a minimum experience of five (5) years as a Maintenance Tradesman
- Computer literate, should possess knowledge of construction and building maintenance; should be versed in reading of CAD drawings
- Excellent interpersonal, communication skills.
- Working knowledge of and proficiency in MS Office Suite.



- Must be able to understand technical literature and follow instructions for any repair and for maintenance procedures.
- Must have a working knowledge of construction materials and methods.
- Must have a basic understanding of plumbing and plumbing methods.
- Must have a working knowledge of mixing and applying concrete, block work and concrete additives.
- Must have a working knowledge of paints, vanishes, and lacquers and use of these materials.
- Must have knowledge of the safe use of hand and power construction tools.
