JOB SUMMARY:

Responsible for the inspections, servicing and installation of electrically operated systems and equipment at the assigned facilities.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Servicing of Electrical Systems and Equipment

- Services and repairs equipment, including but not limited to navigational systems, airfield and ground
 lighting system, Constant Current Regulators, gensets, conveyor systems, commercial lighting systems and
 similar equipment in accordance with the preventive maintenance schedule
- Attends to breakdowns of systems and equipment
- Periodically services and tests all wiring at various facilities, including transformers, and circuit breakers and other electrical components
- Performs routine maintenance and repairs

Installation

• Carries out the installation of new systems or equipment, including airfield and ground lighting installations, andensures that all electrical installations are in accordance with local regulatory electrical and safety standards

Monitoring and Reporting

- Monitors all electrical systems to ensure they are in a proper state of repair and are safe
- Isolates and reports all electrically unsafe systems and equipment
- Inspects wiring of facilities and equipment on a regular basis
- Troubleshoots electrical issues using appropriate testing devices.
- Promptly reports in writing any faults, damage or accident to the supervisor
- Regularly completes forms related to routine and preventive maintenance for all electrical systems and equipment.
- Performs electrical audits and updates the inventory of tools, material and equipment
